What have we been doing this week?

Little pips (9month—2 year room)

This term is about under the sea, so we have been learning about the colour blue. We have had lots of fun with Blue Gloop, painting fish pictures blue and finding sea animals hiding in the blue shaving foam.

we have also added a role play shop for the children to investigate. All the children are really enjoying this, and we have been counting number 1 and number 2. All the children have been looking after the sunflower seed that they planted a few weeks ago and the children will soon be taking them home soon to look after.

Appleblossoms (2-3 year room)

This week we have started our new topic 'Under the sea' through exploring sea animals. We have enjoyed reading our book 'Commotion in the Ocean' and have extended this into the classroom through playing with sea animals in the water tray, painting bubbles by printing, using different materials, scissors and glue to create our own sea pictures, shell printing in play dough and bubble blowing in the garden! Our song of the week has been 1,2,3,4,5 Once I caught a fish alive and the children have created their own colourful fish to hang on our literacy wall. We will continue this topic next week.

Appletree Preschool (3-4 year room)

This week we have enjoyed reading the Rainbow Fish, we made our own beautiful Rainbow Fish. It has been lovely talking with the children about sharing and we shared things that we love like our favourite animals and games. The weather has been very wet but this has helped us enjoy some digging in our flower beds and finding worms! Searching for bugs is a big favourite in pre school!

Scales: The shiny, colourful parts of the fish that are central to the story's message about sharing and friendship.

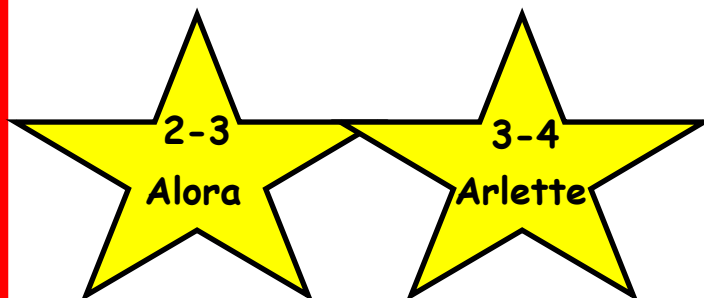
