What have we been doing this week?

Little pips (9month—2 year room)

This week we have enjoyed singing "5 little speckled frogs" so we have been making frogs out of play dough and been practicing the word "ribbit". We have had fun painting pictures of frogs and learning about the colour green and we have also had fun splashing in the water with the frogs too.

This week we have been filling bottles with rice and making shakers to dance with. The boys and girls in Little Pips have been enjoying books this week too.

Appleblossoms (2-3 year room)

This week we have continued our learning of under the sea through exploring boats! The children have enjoyed making boats from junk modelling, straws and paper. We have been learning about floating and sinking with boats in the water and printing with shapes and colours to make our own boat pictures for our row row row your boat literacy wall. We have also been exploring the book 'The Colour Monster' to help us understand our big feelings and have been focusing on how our actions can make our friends feel. We will continue this next week.

Appletree Preschool (3-4 year room)

The children in preschool are loving our new pirate topic. We have been reading 'Pirates love underpants' which is a very funny story about a group of pirates who love. Outside we have been using the crates to make our own pirate ships. In the writing area we have been making treasure maps and marking an X to show where the treasure is hidden.

We have had lots of pirate costumes and pirate hats which we have been wearing and roleplaying being a pirate.

Phonics

We have been exploring different voice sounds such as boing boing for a ball or wheeee for a slide.

Maths

This week we have used our numbered treasure chests and counted out the correct number of doubloons.

Word of the week

Doubloon - A Spanish gold coin historically used or stolen by pirates.

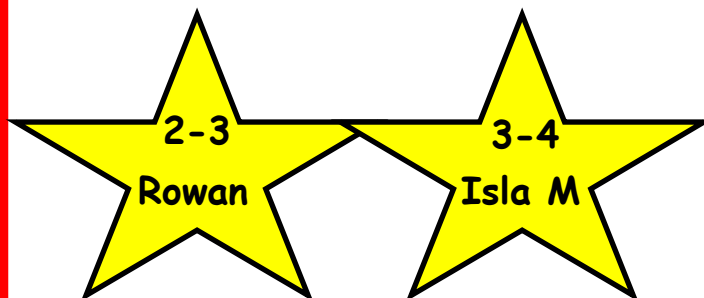
